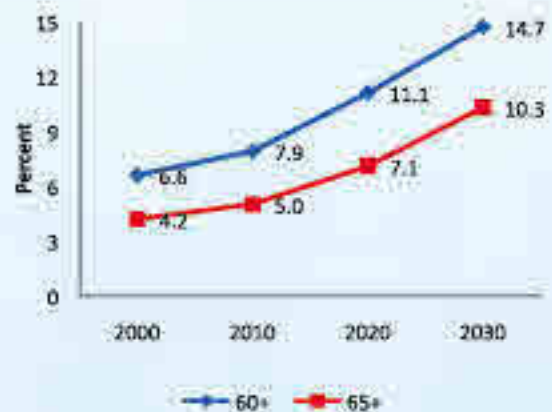

Ageing Population, 2000-2030

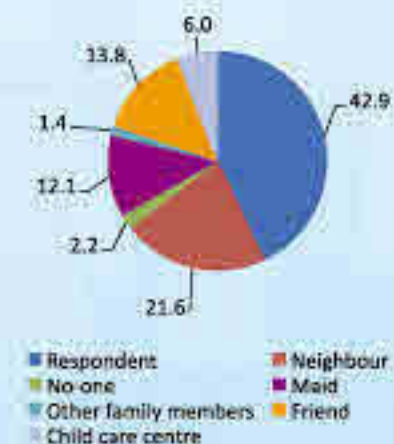


Ethnicity of Malaysian citizens (%)

Type of Child Care Among Working Women, Peninsular Malaysia, 2004

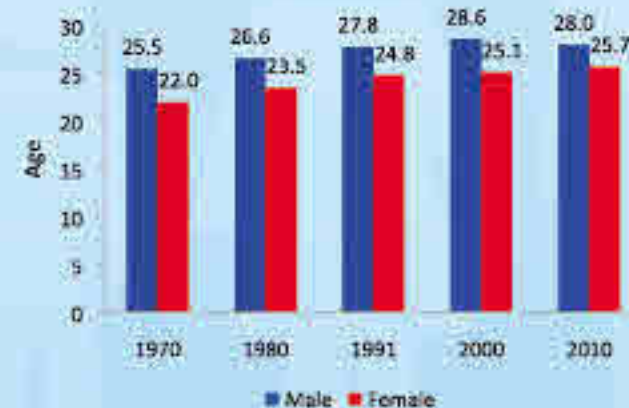

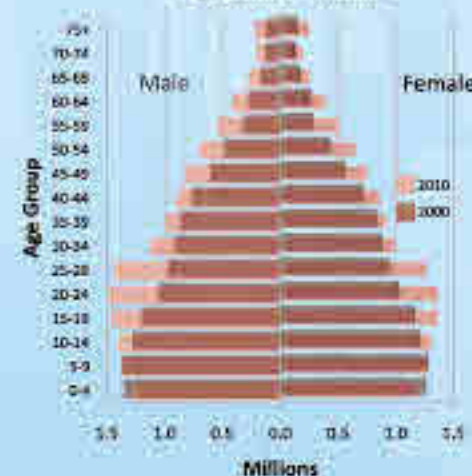
Proportion of Never Married Population Aged 15 year and over (%)
